INTRODUCTION

On 23 Mar 1889, President Benjamin Harrison issued a proclamation for opening the unassigned lands to white settlers making the way for the formation of Oklahoma Territory. Earlier that year the United States acquired title to the Unassigned District from the Creek and Seminole Indian Tribes. Approximately two-thirds of present day Cleveland County was opened to settlement in the first land opening, a land run, on 22 April 1889.

The same bill which authorized the opening of these lands also established a townsite which later became the county seat at Norman. It wasn't, however, until 24 May 1890 that Oklahoma Territory's first governor, George W. Steele, an appointee of President Harrison, determined the boundaries of six counties within the "unassigned lands" and gave them numerical designations. Cleveland County was first known as the "third" county. Its boundaries were the Indian Treaty line of 1866 on the east, the South Canadian River on the south, the "fourth" county (Canadian) on the west and what is now Southwest 59th Street of Oklahoma City on the north.

By July 1890 the "third" county had a functioning county government at Norman, which took its name from the railroad station ground that was established two years before the opening of the unassigned lands. The name Cleveland County was adopted 5 August 1890 by a vote of the people.

The third land opening in Oklahoma Territory was a "land run" for the Sac and Fox, Iowa, Pottawatomie and Shawnee Indian lands. This run on 22 September 1891 changed the boundaries of Cleveland County to its present size and shape. These changes are of particular interest to those who might have had ancestors living in that two mile strip on the northern boundary since they would have been residents of Cleveland County prior to that date. Indian Land Allotment records for the eastern third of the county will also be found in the Cleveland County records.

The First Territorial Legislature, by an act of December 1890, established the University of Oklahoma at Norman. The first state mental institution was located in Norman. It is interesting to note that there not being any other place to care for them, many Civil War Veterans were placed in Central State Hospital (the mental institution). Many who died there were interred in the I.O.O.F. Cemetery in Norman.

Cleveland County's population in 1890 was 7,011. Microfilm copies of population schedules for the 1890 and 1900 Census of Oklahoma Territory and the 1910 Oklahoma Census are available at the Oklahoma Historical Society Library, Wiley Post Building, Oklahoma City, OK.

Before 1889, with the exception of the panhandle in the northwest and "old" Greer County in the southwest corner, all of the area that comprises the present state of Oklahoma was Indian Territory. Although the Indians in the eastern half of the Indian Territory had functioning tribal governments, including county or district courts, few records of marriage are extant. The exceptions would be marriages between non-Indians and Indians.

Until the 1890s there was not a county or district court in which to file marriages between non-Indians residing in the Indian Territory. This does not mean marriages between non-Indians did not take place. Many couples were married in counties which bordered the Indian Territory in Arkansas, Kansas, Missouri, Texas and after 1889 the Oklahoma Territory. Other couples were married in the Indian Territory by ministers and other officials who resided here. Although the records of these marriages may not be of record in any court, the couple may have been given a certificate of marriage, or the marriage could have been recorded in a church or minister's register.

This volume contains marriage records transcribed from the original Register of Marriages 1891-1897: Cleveland County, Territory of Oklahoma. Although the early penmanship was often difficult to decipher we have attempted to publish as accurate and complete a record as possible. The original spelling and punctuation has been retained. All information from the original register, with the exception of the dates of filing, are found in this publication.

The value of this publication to genealogists with Cleveland County ancestors is apparent. Researchers working on families who resided in the Indian Territory (where records on non-Indians are scarce) will find it equally valuable. Cleveland County, bordered on the south by the Chickasaw Nation, appears to have been a favorite place for Indian Territory couples to be married. Nearly twenty percent of the marriages in this volume have an Indian Territory connection. Nor are the marriages limited to couples from Cleveland County and Indian Territory. Several other Oklahoma Territory counties are represented, and many individuals were listed as being residents of other states.


The place names below the names of the groom and bride list their respective residences. The place name below the date of marriage is where the marriage occurred. When the date of filing was the same as the date of the marriage it was not included. If there was no date of filing or a discrepancy between that date and the marriage date a notation has been made.

The page number refers to the page number of the original register; the (#) refers to the line number on this page. The last line of each abstract gives the name of the official, his credentials (when given), and remarks. An asterisk indicates specific remarks or additional information. Editors' remarks are enclosed in brackets.


The marriage entries are in alphabetical order by the groom's surname. A guide to place names; bibliography; separate bride-to-groom index; a listing of magistrates, ministers and other officials; plus an index to officials and others are included.

It should be noted that this register does not include all of the marriages which took place between 1891 and 1897. Cleveland County marriage records begin in June 1890 with Marriage Book One. Plans are underway to publish Book One as Special Publication Number II.



ADDENDUM

Newspapers contain valuable information for the genealogist. Although a secondary source, they aid us in our search for ancestors. Newspapers provide us with clues for further research, lend insight to life in the community and help verify important occurrences in the lives of our ancestors.

Early Cleveland County newspapers include those published in Lexington, Moore, Noble and Norman. Many are available on microfilm at the Oklahoma Historical Society in Oklahoma City and the Norman Public Library.

When transcribing this marriage register, if there was a question regarding names or dates, compilers checked for marriage notices in local newspapers. Note following abstracts:

"James ALLEN and Mrs. Della CRISWELL both of this city were united in bonds of holy wedlock on last Sunday evening by Rev. J.T. HENDERICKSON. The Transcript extends congratulations."

The Norman Transcript, 17 February 1893, p.8, col. 2.

It was impossible to determine, from the marriage register, if the groom was James ALLEN or Allen JAMES. The date of marriage was entered as 12 Feb 1892; the date of filing was 13 Feb 1893. The above abstract solved both problems.

"Mr. Corbin JOHNSON and Mrs. Fannie HAGER of Fort Worth, Texas were married while on the Santa Fe train going north the other day by W.L. ROSS. They have a number of friends in the city who wish them happiness and prosperity."

The Norman Transcript, 21 April 1893, p. 10, col. 1.

In this instance it was difficult to determine the bride's name. The marriage notice helped to verify that, while also giving a delightful description of where the marriage took place.
