#### FIRST FAMILIES OF CLEVELAND COUNTY

On 13 March 1989, we entertained each other and about 60 visitors at the first informal meeting of descendants of Cleveland County's Pioneer Families. Names that strike proud chords of response in every Oklahoman, both native and adopted, showed up in good numbers, enthusiastically greeting the host group and embracing, literally in a good many cases, each other. Tecumseh, Spencer, Yukon and Chickasha were represented as well as Moore, Norman, and Oklahoma City.

Each visitor took the opportunity to introduce him- or herself and tell briefly about his ancestor(s) who settled in the area. Many "cousinships" were renewed and recalled: a few were established. It was an extremely enthusiastic group that made for a successful meeting.

The Highlight of the evening was the presentation by President Agnes BROOKS, of the #1 Membership to Jonathan WILHITE, son of Tom and Donna WILHITE. Jonathan celebrated his 9th birthday just a few days after he became #1.

Members of the society were available to help prospective First Family members with the application forms and necessary proof papers. Refreshments were served and the parting remarks seemed to be, "When are we going to do this again?" Irene PETRICK, the newly-named chairman of the First Families committee is considering a "homecoming" type celebration such as a covered dish dinner in one of the Norman city parks.
