Marriage Records of the first two books have been verified. Completion date is uncertain.

Our members report that they have had good luck with the new Census Ordering System. If you have been putting off ordering film, make a trip to the Moore or Norman Library and order your film. Charge is \$3.00 for a seven day period. Expect to wait about three weeks for your delivery.

SPECIAL SOLUTION SAVES CLIPPINGS????

This information for keeping newspapers or newspaper clippings from turning yellow and crumbling might be of interest to you.

Dissolve a milk of magnesia tablet (or 1 tablespoon of milk of magnesia emulsion) in a quart of club soda. Cover tightly and let stand in the refrigerator overnight.

Pour into a pan large enough to accommodate the newspaper clippings. Soak for one to two hours; remove, and pat dry.

Plan to treat all your clippings at one time, because this solution cannot be reused.

The estimated life of treated newspaper is 200 years.

Chemically, the magnesium oxide combines with the carbon dioxide in the soda to form magnesium carbonate which neutralizes acids in the paper that causes deterioration.
