This year the Moore 1921-58 Alumni Association, Inc. purchased flags for Veteran's Graves in the Moore area. They were assisted in placing these in the SUNSET, FAIRVIEW, SMITH, LILAC HILL, AND MOORE cemeteries by the American Legion Post 184, VFW Post 8706 and local Boy Scout troops. GREAT NEWS: The National Archives and Records (NARS) has contracted with a private firm, DDD Company of Landover, Maryland, to operate a Census Microfilm Rental Program. Individuals may order census microfilm after 5 June through the Inter-library loan section of a public library. Actual distribution of film will begin on 8 July. The films will rent for \$2.25 per roll for a seven day period. The program is designed to provide either immediate service upon receipt of an order or immediate scheduling the notification of date film will be shipped.

Initially, the 1790 to 1900 census schedules and Soundex will be available. Later this year the schedules and Soundex for the 1910 census will become available. The contractor is currently distributing program details and order forms to public libraries and many genealogical associations.

NOTE: I have checked with the Norman and the Moore Library, and they have not as yet set up with the material, but do keep checking with them for information.

The Census Microfilm Rental Program replaces the free inter-library loan of microfilm that was discontinued in 1981 because of NARS budget reductions.
